The objective of the project is to allow students to focus their multidisciplinary background on a real social (or corporate) issue presented by an external client, and to propose a solution in the form of for example a (policy) recommendation or other final report.

WHEN

The project runs over 2.5 months (11 weeks), in which groups of a maximum of 10 students analyse the case, conduct research and write a proposal/research report in a team effort, within which they are largely responsible for the way in which they organize themselves.

- The weeks are usually used as follows:
 - problem analysis
 - o research
 - formulating a proposal
 - report writing and presenting the proposal
- Period: April through first half of May (part-time), and second half of May through first half of June (full-time).
- Students: Predominantly third year students participate in Think Tank. The project is advanced level for bachelor's students.

UCM OFFERS

 An opportunity to have a group of highly motivated and knowledgeable students investigate complex issues from an interdisciplinary perspective, leading to a recommendation aimed at application in practice. Clients can expect, for example: A profound and rich analysis of their problem, a new perspective, things to do, criteria for success.

UCM ASKS

- Availability of one or more representatives of the client for:
 - Developing the assignment (prior to the project; one or two meetings).
 - Presenting the assignment (start of the project, one meeting).
 - o Receiving and commenting on the initial problem analysis (during the project, one meeting).
 - Receiving the final report and presentation (end of the project, one meeting).
 - Giving in between advice, feedback, etc.

- UCM is the Liberal Arts and Sciences honours college of Maastricht University.
- 3-year program. End degree: Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Sciences, with the aim of pursuing a Master's degree afterwards.
- Students design their own curriculum based on a broad range of courses, working towards a clear focus ('open curriculum').
- Students focus within one of three concentrations: Social Sciences, Humanities or Sciences.
